

Customer's Own Material (COM)

All COM should be shipped prepaid to: OCI Seating 14815 Radburn Avenue Santa Fe Springs, CA 90670

Collect shipments of COM/COL fabrics will not be accepted. OCI Seating assumes no responsibility for the quality durability or sustainability of COM Materials. Surplus COM will be returned to the customer only if specifically requested. Please furnish a sample cutting of COM or COL with the original purchase order so that identification of COM/COL can be verified. In the absence of specific written instructions accompanying the order, fabrics will be cut, seamed, and applied at our discretion and at the customer's own risk. An additional up charge may be assessed for COM or COL materials that are deemed abnormal and additional labor required to cut, sew and/or match these said materials. Please specify on the purchase order the direction you wish your pattern to run on the chair. Vertical or Horizontal.



All yardage figures are based upon our receipt of plain 54" wide material. Extra fabric is required to match any pattern with matching repeats. Please use chart below as a guide and add to playing yardage requirements listed in your price book.

Fabric Repeat	Increase COM Requirement by:
2.9 and under	0%
3" - 11.9" Repeat	18%
12" - 16.9" Repeat	25%
17" – 20.9"	30%
21" - 27.9"	35%
28" - and above	40%

While OCI Seating inspects all fabrics for imperfections from the mill, some imperfections are difficult to recognize. OCI Seating cannot be responsible for defects, dye lot variations, color accuracies and other flaws and suggest that our customers inspect fabrics before furnishing them to us. OCI Seating will not assume responsibility for COM/COL shortages, flaws, or other such problems. OCI Seating will not be responsible for order/delivery delays caused by delays in the delivery of COM/COL fabrics to OCI Seating.

All COM orders are not put into production until all COM is received and approved. Upon receipt of COM, the order will then be placed into our normal production schedule. If there is a combination of OCI Seating fabrics and COM on the order, please advise customer service if you wish to split the order for shipping. Applicable drop ship charges will apply.

Fabrics

Some COM fabrics, polyurethane fabrics and PVC free materials may be susceptible to puddling or comfort wrinkles overtime. While we will do our best to eliminate it, this is sometimes due to the inherent properties of the fabric and not an indication of inferior upholstery techniques. Please keep this in mind when selecting fabrics for upholstery.

COM Pricing

The approved COM price for non-directional fabric is the Grade 1 price and the approved COL (Customer Own Leather) is Grade 3. For all chair series, hand cut and matched stripes, patterns or prints you must add the up chart below.

Chair/Lounge - \$95 List Love Seat - \$105 List Sofa - \$145 List

Flammability

OCI Seating manufacturers all its chairs to comply with California technical bulletin #117 (Cal TB 117). If customer's own material is specified, OCI Seating is not liable for said COM fabrics non-compliance with Cal TB 117.

On January 22nd, 2019, California Technical bulletin number 133, the Flammability Test Procedure for Seating Furniture for use in Public Occupancies, was replaced by the California legislature. If compliance to TB 133 is required, add \$70 list per yard of fabric utilized by the seating product specified for the application of fire barrier.

Application of Fabric

OCI Seating requires that all COM fabrics come "backed" with, at minimum, an acrylic or similar backing. We cannot be responsible for stretching of fabrics that are not "backed" during upholstery process. OCI Seating cannot be held responsible for the appearance, behavior, quality, or performance of any COM as well as COM that are rolled reverse by the fabric supplier.

The application of patterned fabrics on curved units will be stitched to match pattern requirements. All patterns will be stitched together to produce the best results. Modifications to the stitching pattern can occur to gain the best look or results when matching patterns.
